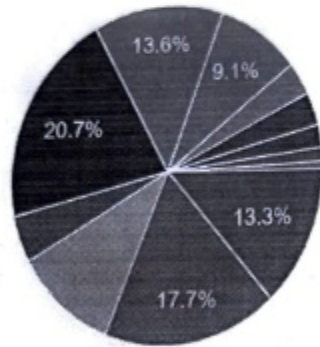

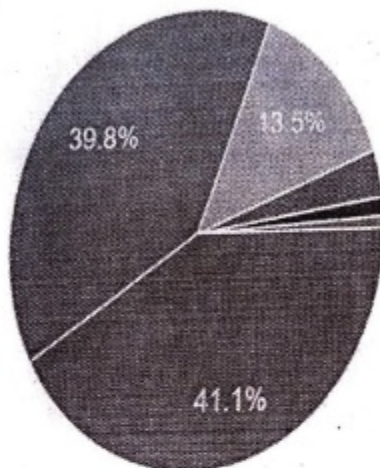

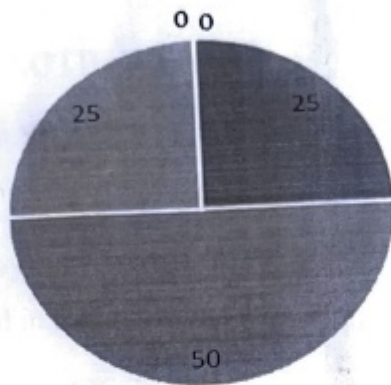

STUDENTS FEEDBACK AND ACTION TAKEN REPORT

The students response to various aspects with regard to relevance, content of the curriculum student placement and employability were analysed and based on their feedback, action were carried out which in presented in the following table.

SL. No	FEEDBACK	ACTION TAKEN
1	Lectures are too long and lack engagement.	Implemented interactive teaching methods such as group discussions, case studies, and multimedia presentations to make lectures more engaging. Also, broke down longer lectures into shorter segments with active learning activities in between.
2	Difficulty in understanding course material due to language barriers or complex terminology.	Provided additional resources such as supplementary readings, online tutorials, and peer-led study sessions. Offered language support workshops and encouraged peer collaboration for language comprehension. Simplified explanations and provided real-world examples to aid understanding.
3	Inadequate feedback on assignments and exams.	Implemented a timely feedback system where assignments and exams are graded promptly. Introduced rubrics to provide clear expectations and criteria for assessment. Offered office hours and online feedback sessions to discuss individual performance and address any concerns.

4	Limited opportunities for student engagement and participation in class discussions.	Implemented small group activities, peer-led discussions, and online forums to encourage student interaction. Provided incentives for active participation and created a supportive environment where students feel comfortable expressing their thoughts and opinions.
5	Inadequate support for mental health and well-being.	Expanded counseling services and mental health resources on campus, including individual therapy, support groups, and crisis intervention services. Offered mental health awareness campaigns, workshops, and training sessions to reduce stigma and promote self-care strategies. Collaborated with community mental health organizations to provide off-campus referrals and additional support options. Established peer support programs and student-led initiatives to foster a culture of well-being and resilience within the college community.
